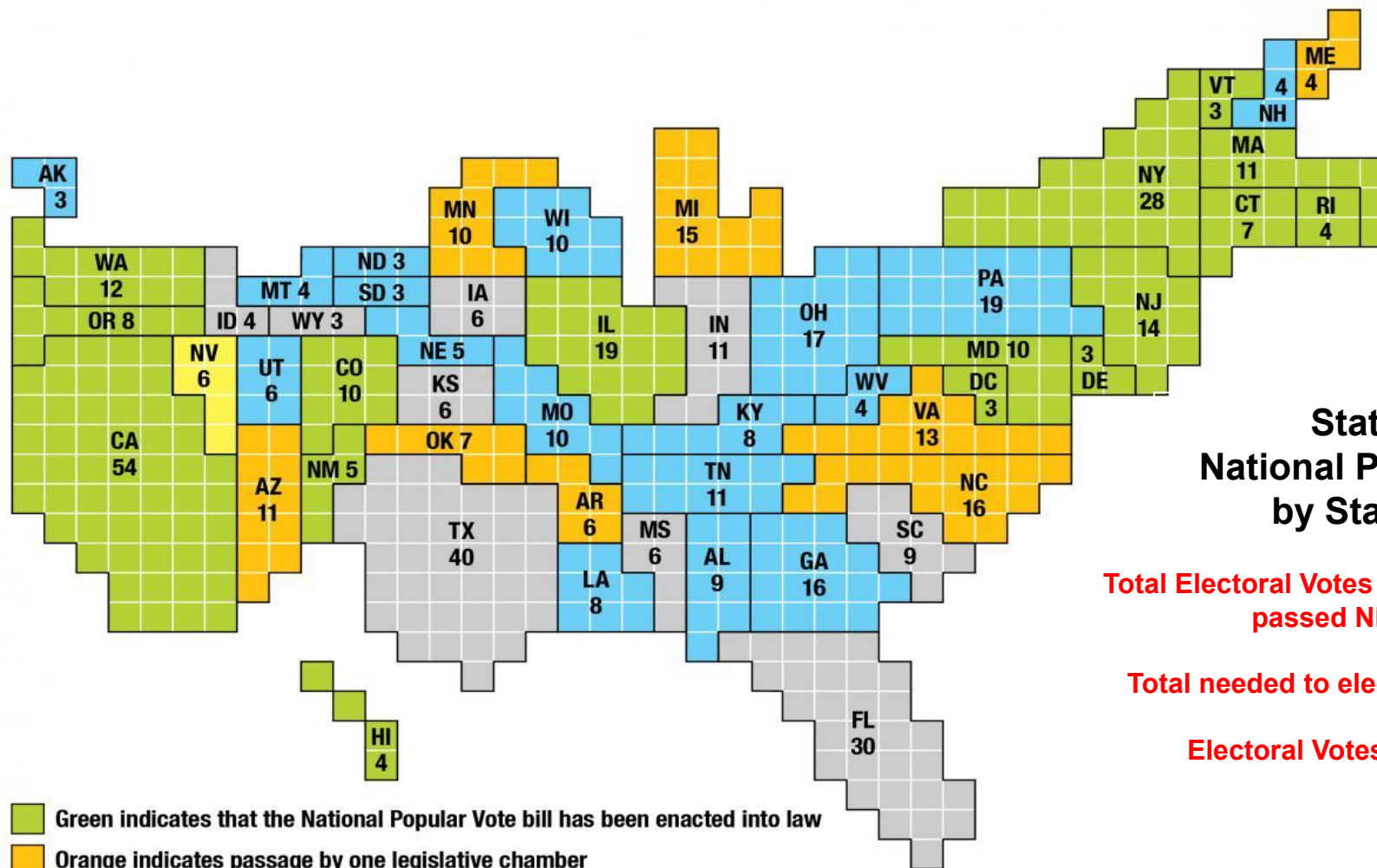


## The National Popular Vote bill (HB 69 and SB 584)

Guarantees the candidate with the most votes in all 50 states becomes president

*Preserves the Electoral College*

*Does NOT require a constitutional amendment*



### Status of National Popular Vote by State 2021

Total Electoral Votes in states that have passed NPV: 195

Total needed to elect President: 270

Electoral Votes needed: 75

- Green indicates that the National Popular Vote bill has been enacted into law
- Orange indicates passage by one legislative chamber
- Yellow indicates passage by both legislative chambers
- Blue indicates a hearing by at least one legislative committee
- Gray indicates bill introduced, but no hearing

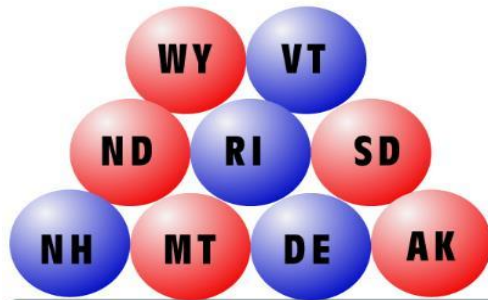
**In a National Popular Vote, all votes would be equal.**

*Currently, Florida's 30 electoral votes each represent 717,933 residents.*

*These 9 small states with 30 electoral votes each represent 264,592 residents.*

**A small state's electoral vote is worth nearly 3 times a Floridian's vote!**
